RESIDENTIAL EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO - DELAMERE OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTRE

An educational visit has been arranged for **Year 2** to Delamere Outdoor Education Centre for one overnight stay on the following days:

- Class 2D Tuesday 6th November – Wednesday 7th November**
- Class 2B Wednesday 7th November – Thursday 8th November**

Transport will be provided by Aimee’s Travel Coaches. The Coach will leave school at 9.15 a.m. and the predicted time of return is approximately 3.00 p.m. The visit will help to develop the children’s thinking skills and independence as well as enhancing this terms topic ‘I’m An Explorer GET ME OUT OF HERE!’.

Please return the attached parental consent form and pay a deposit of £30.00 using our on-line ParentPay system by Monday 1st October to secure a place and to enable the visit arrangements to be completed and confirmed. Payment(s) should be made by an on-line instalment, (please see the Consent Form for payment details) and full payment should be received by Thursday 1st November at the latest.

As this is an overnight visit, it is necessary to ask for a payment of **£65.00** per pupil which is subsidised by the school.

This cost will go towards:

- **Delamere Education Centre residential fee**
- **Travel arrangements – Aimee’s Travel**

All pupils will need a packed lunch and drink on the first day of their visit. All other meals will be provided. Key stage 1 are children entitled to free school meals under the UFSM scheme, therefore if your child would like a packed lunch provided on the first day, please indicate on the consent form.

As we will be travelling by coach, your child will be expected to be responsible enough to wear any seatbelt provided until informed it may be released.

As this is a residential visit, medical information and dietary needs about all participants will be required. Advance warning is needed of any participants with special medical or other needs to ensure all health and safety considerations have been made. Parents must inform the school of any relevant medical or other needs on the visit consent form.

As we will be travelling by coach, your child will be expected to wear any seatbelt provided until informed it may be released. All bona fide educational visits by Shaw Education Trust are covered by the trust’s liability insurance via the EFA’s Risk Protection Arrangement or Zurich Insurance, as are all in-school activities. The visit is considered to have only normal everyday risks and no further insurance has been provided.
